## Short Summary

According to the Southern Mongolian Human Rights Information Center (SMHRIC), authorities in the Inner Mongolia Autonomous Region (IMAR) detained Mongolian rights activist and journalist Naranbilig at his home in Hohhot on March 23, 2008, to prevent him from attending the United Nations Permanent Forum on Indigenous Issues in New York. SMHRIC also connected Naranbilig's detention to his attendance in 2007 at other international fora promoting the rights of pastoralists and mobile indigenous people and to his broader activities writing articles advocating ethnic minority rights. SMHRIC reported that authorities released him on bail on April 23, 2008, and placed him under "house arrest" within his home for one year.
