Short Summary

According to CHRD and Civil Rights and Livelihood Watch, on November 6, 2007, authorities ordered Wang Ling, a Beijing petitioner and activist, to serve 1 year and 3 months' reeducation through labor at the Beijing Daxing Women's RTL Center. Officials reportedly punished her for petitioning activities relating to the inadequate compensation she allegedly received after her housing was demolished four years previously to make room for Olympics-related construction. Wang worked with Ye Guozhu in assisting other petitioners to defend their rights. Wang has been released from RTL and lives in Beijing, but is currently under strict surveillance and control. The police officers who monitor Wang have reportedly beaten her. During the March 2009 "two Congresses," Wang has, in effect, been confined to her home.
