Short Summary

According to SMHRIC ([4 December 10](#), [8 December 10](#), [11 December 10](#), [27 December 10](#), [5 May 11](#), [8 July 11](#), [10 December 11](#)), public security officers in Saihan district, Hohhot, Inner Mongolia, detained Mongol bookstore owner Xinna at her bookstore on December 4, 2010, in connection to the upcoming scheduled release from prison of her husband, Mongol activist [Hada](#). Authorities said she had "run an illegal business." They took items from the store including books and CDs and searched a warehouse, confiscating Xinna's diary, her son's computer, business records, and other items. Xinna has promoted the rights of Mongols and advocated for her husband, whose 15-year prison sentence expired on December 10, 2010. Authorities also took Xinna and Hada's son [Ujiles](#) into custody on December 4 and detained him again on December 5. SMHRIC connected the events to official efforts to quell publicity about Hada's release. Authorities formally arrested her around January 17, 2011. Xinna is held in the Hohhot No. 1 PSB Detention Center. She has a heart condition. Her sister reported to SMHRIC in December 2011 that she is in poor health and lacks medical care.
