## Short Summary

According to CHRDL (English, [21 February 11](#)) and the Guardian (English, [18 February 11](#)), public security officials in Xuanwu district, Beijing municipality, detained human rights lawyer Tang Jitian on the evening of February 16, 2011, after he attended a lunch meeting to discuss rights defender [Chen Guangcheng](#) with rights activists. According to the Guardian, public security officials reportedly took Tang to a police station in Xuanwu. Rights lawyer [Teng Biao](#) later told the Guardian that public security officials in Xuanwu reported Tang had been transferred to the Beijing Municipal Public Security Bureau, but Teng stated that the Beijing Municipal Public Security Bureau reported that it had no information on Tang. According to SCMP ([21 April 11](#)) and AFP ([13 April 11](#)), authorities placed Tang under a state described as "house arrest" in March 2011, and he reportedly is suffering from tuberculosis. In April 2010, the Beijing Municipal Justice Bureau [held](#) a hearing to revoke the lawyer's licenses of Tang and Liu Wei, another Beijing rights lawyer, in connection with their representation of a Falun Gong practitioner in 2009 in Sichuan province.
