Short Summary

According to CAA ([15 June 11](#), English; [15 June 11](#), Chinese), starting on May 31, 2011, public security bureau (PSB) officials in Suqian city, Jiangsu province, held unregistered Protestant pastor Shi Enhao in administrative detention for 12 days in apparent connection to his activities as an unregistered pastor. He was released on June 12, but PSB officials took him into custody the same day. According to a notice from the Suqian Municipal PSB, via CAA ([5 July 11](#), Chinese), on June 21, Suqian PSB officials criminally detained Shi on suspicion of "using superstition to undermine the implementation of the law" (language similar to Art. 300 of the [Criminal Law](#)). According to RFA ([26 July 11](#)), authorities later ordered Shi to serve two years of reeducation through labor (RTL), although sources do not specify the date of the order or the RTL location. Unregistered pastor [Zhang Mingxuan](#) reportedly said that Shi was ordered to serve RTL for holding "illegal gatherings" and establishing "illegal churches." According to CAA (23 January 12), authorities released Shi on January 20, 2012, and he returned home. CAA reported it did not have information on the basis for early release.
