Short Summary

According to Chinese Human Rights Defenders (CHRD) ([31 March 11](#)), on February 20, 2011, public security officials in Shanghai municipality reportedly detained Shanghai-based petitioner-activist Tan Lanying and petitioner Yang Lamei, in apparent connection to petitioning. On February 21, 2011, police officials criminally detained Tan on suspicion of "gathering a crowd to disturb social order," a crime under Article 290(1) of the [Criminal Law](#). Authorities detained Tan at the Putuo District PSB Detention Center, Shanghai municipality. According to Boxun ([11 April 11](#)), Chinese authorities released Tan and Yang on March 23, 2011. CHRD reports that Tan has petitioned for 17 years in connection to the forced demolition of her home.
