Short Summary

According to Chinese Human Rights Defenders (CHRD) ([31 March 11](#)), on February 20, 2011, public security officials in Shanghai municipality reportedly detained Shanghai-based petitioner Yang Lamei. An eyewitness reportedly saw officials detain Yang along with Shanghai petitioner-activist Tan Lanying, who was criminally detained on suspicion of "gathering a crowd to disturb social order," a crime under Article 290(1) of the [Criminal Law](#). According to Boxun ([11 April 11](#)), Chinese authorities released Yang and Tan on March 23, 2011.
