Short Summary

Based on TCHRD ([18 December 12](#)) and RFA ([18 December 12](#)) reports, on December 3, 2012, public security officials from police stations located in Amuqu (Achog) and Bola (Bora) townships in Xiahe (Sangchu) county, Gannan (Kanlho) TAP, Gansu province, detained five Bora Monastery monks: Gedun Gyatso (age 47), Lobsang Phagpa (34), Jamyang Zoepa (25), Jamyang Lodroe (about 20), and Jamyang Gyatso (about 20). Police reportedly took the monks away for "interrogation" the day after the December 2 self-immolation of Sangdu Kyab (see TCHRD, [25 December 12](#)), a married father of one child. Information is unavailable on the monks' location and status. (According to Gansu Daily (Chinese, [3 December 12](#); translated in OSC, [11 December 12](#)), the Supreme People's Court, Supreme People's Procuratorate, and Ministry of Public Security issued a joint "[opinion](#)" calling for persons authorities regard as linked to a self-immolation to be prosecuted for "intentional murder.")
